This scholarship was established to honor former Representative Janet Miller following her death in 2007. Rep. Janet Miller worked tirelessly for four decades to serve the people of the Great State of Idaho as a respected member of her community and of the Republican Party. She worked at all levels of Party leadership, including serving as President of the Idaho Federation of Republican Women, Region IV Chairman, District 17 Chairman, Precinct Committeeperson and endeavored to elect Republicans to office.

Representative Miller believed that one person can make the world a better place, and showed us so by her selfless actions and unending pursuit to make Idaho a better place for the elderly, our families and children.

The Janet Miller scholarship will provide three (3) one-hundred dollar (\$100) scholarships to members of the Ada County Republican Women's Club in her memory.

A. Selection Criteria

- A member of good standing
- Promotes the Republican ideals
- Is involved in events and meetings

Is involved in the Republican party

B. Selection Process

- Letters of Request may be submitted to the Scholarship Committee Chairman by any member that wishes to apply for the Janet Miller scholarship.

All letters will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee and recommendations of award will be submitted to the ACRWC Executive Board for approval.

C. Distribution of Scholarship Money

Monies may be spent for the following activities:

- Campaign school
- Conferences or leadership schools that focus on Republican ideals and issues
- IFRW and NFRW registration fees not to exceed \$100.00

The Janet Miller Scholarship is precluded from being used for sending delegates to the Republican National Convention.
